## 2020 RED SKYWALKER

The fresh winds of this maritime region provide ideal conditions for producing an exceptional Pinot Noir. Skywalker Pinot Noir embodies purity, grace, and finesse, fully expressing the unique character of its terroir. The most refined techniques are used to craft this prestigious wine, sought after and recognized throughout the world.



GRAPE :  
100% Pinot noir

HARVEST :  
Manual harvest, in 25 kg crates

SOILS :  
A hilly region dominated by sandstone, silt, and shale. These shallow, rocky soils provide excellent drainage, giving the grapes a highly concentrated aroma. Specific plots and rows are selected based on their sun exposure. The rocky soil, present in all plots, forces the roots to seek out fertile soil to produce intensely flavored fruit. The rocks in the soil retain the sun's heat, allowing the roots to extend the growing season and the fruit to ripen slowly.

ALTITUDE :  
300m

VINIFICATION :  
Grapes from different plots are fermented separately in stainless steel tanks and aged in new French oak barrels. At every stage of the winemaking process, we ensure that we use the best techniques to produce this Pinot Noir

AGED :  
Vinification and aging in barrels for 12 months. 30% of the volume in new French oak barrels

TO THE EYE :  
Deep ruby color

NOSE :  
Soft aromas of black raspberries and hints of cardamom, vanilla and black tea

PALATE :  
Fruity liveliness of a bowl of cherries, leaving a silkiness on the palate

FOOD PAIRING :  
Red meats in sauces, such as flank steak with pepper sauce and baby potatoes

AGING :  
10 years
