Inspired by the vision of George Lucas, Skywalker Vineyards was founded in 1991. However, the origins of George Lucas's winemaking dream date back to his childhood in Modesto, California. A place surrounded by vineyards, where the scent of fermenting grapes hung in the air, steeped in the culture of the vineyard and winemaking. Today, you have the privilege to discover premium wines that will delight the most passionate oenophiles.

Planted atop the ridge of Skywalker Ranch, the Sommità Pinot Noir is a perfect example of cool-climate Pinot Noir's production, with a beautiful balance of crisp acidity and supple, firm tannins, as well as a unique aromatic profile.

100% Pinot Noir

**H A R V E S T :**  
Manual harvest, in 25 kg crates, each plot is selected for its coolness

**S O I L S :**  
Hilly and rocky area. These mountainous soils offer excellent drainage, meaning the vines have limited access to water that would dilute the aromas of their grapes. The roots are forced to dig deep into the rocky layers to find sustenance. This results in low yields and gives the wine subtle aromas and a distinctive minerality. Wines produced from these grapes offer excellent aroma concentration and good varietal character.

**A L T I T U D E :**  
300m

**V I N I F A T I O N :**  
Fermentation in small quantities in stainless steel vats

**A G E D :**  
Aged in French oak barrels, produced by hand using a process that does not mask the nuances of the wine

**T O T H E E Y E :**  
Deep ruby color with purple highlights

**N O S E :**  
Bright tones of dried aromatic herbs, rose petals and small red berries

**P A L A T E :**  
On the palate, lively red fruits of cherry and cranberry mix with dark, woody tones of allspice and cedar. Palate offers a joyful sense of ripeness, pleasure, and harmony

**F O O D P A I R I N G :**  
As an aperitif with peppered salamis and hard cheeses, or duck aiguillettes with foie gras
